The Peter Hess® Therapy Singing Bowls Premium (Hess Sound)

- were developed in 1989 for professional sound work with the Peter Hess[®] Sound Massage and Sound Methods
- have an excellent sound and vibration behavior
- are made by hand in India and Nepal using a traditional forging process – each singing bowl is unique
- consist of a high-quality bronze made of pure metals with the main components copper and tin as well as other metals and a "secret ingredient"
- · undergo multiple strict quality controls
- · are also available with a permanent coating



There are different types of singing bowls with a specific sound and frequency spectrum for certain areas of the body, such as the Pelvic, Heart or Head Bowl (see Part 2).

The most important bowls for sound massage are:



Universal Bowl – Frequency range ~ 100 Hz – 2800 Hz Weight: 900 g – 1000 g · Ø: 20 cm – 22.5 cm · Height: 8 cm – 9 cm Characteristics: intensive vibration behavior with a broad sound spectrum, sound is described as moving and "loosening" Area of application: extremities, entire body, therefore typical "beginner's bowl"



Pelvic Bowl (small/large) – Frequency range ~ 100 Hz – 1000 Hz Weight: 1400 g – 2200 g \cdot Ø: 25.5 cm – 30 cm \cdot Height: 10 cm – 12 cm

Characteristics: deep sound spectrum, very calming and centering, often described as particularly "grounding"

Area of application: lower back, pelvic area, feet



Heart Bowl (small/large) – with lower or higher sound

Frequency range: ~ 200 Hz – 1200 Hz

Weight: $650 \text{ g} - 1350 \text{ g} \cdot \text{Ø}$: $17 \text{ cm} - 23 \text{ cm} \cdot \text{Height}$: 6.5 cm - 9.5 cm Characteristics: with a deep tone rather relaxing / with a high tone rather stimulating, sound is described as soft, "heart-opening", but also as focusing

Area of application: heart area, base of neck, shoulder blades

Other types of singing bowls:

Head Bowl

Weight: 200 g – 350 g · Ø: 10 cm – 14 cm · Height: 3 cm – 5.5 cm

There are thin-walled and thick-walled Head Bowls in a wide, bulbous or small version

Characteristics: thin-walled bowls - high and moving sound, rather relaxing · thick-

walled bowls – high sound, rather focusing, centering, "direct"

Area of application: head area such as forehead and sinuses, aura

Throat Bowl

Weight: 650 g – 730 g · Ø: 17 cm · Height: 6.5 cm

Characteristics: high, warm sound

Range of application: vocal/lute-forming body area, upper body area, décolleté

Solar Plexus Bowl

Weight: 1100 g - 1300 g \cdot Ø: 23.5 cm \cdot Height: 9 cm - 10 cm

Characteristics: rather deep sounds

Area of application: stomach and upper abdominal area

XL Bowl

Weight: 4 kg - 20 kg · Ø 38 cm - 65 cm

Height: 15 cm - 25 cm

Characteristics: very deep, long-lasting sound Range of use: ideal for tuning in and arrival at the

beginning and for "grounding" at the end of a

sound massage / sound session

Area of application: individual and group work
